1.0 INTRODUCTION

The University of Dar es Salaam Computing Centre (UCC) Offers a Certificate course in Business Information Technology (CBIT). This Certificate is a premium course that puts graduates in high demand as IT plays an increasingly important role in the business world today. This course is especially designed to keep students **focused** in both IT and business. Up-to date IT skills are integrated with extensive business knowledge to enhance the competitiveness in career advancement of graduates. Building on this foundation, the subsequent stages offer modules that prepare students well to excel in the areas of Web services, IT, Business development skills, Basic programming skills, Basics of Accounting, Entrepreneurship and Management principles.

2.0 CORSE OBJECTIVES

The course aims to equip students with:

- Knowledge of accounting, management principles, business planning and development, and entrepreneurial skills
- A good understanding of the business concepts, strategic opportunities in the variously sector.
- Effectively use of accounting packages in real life environment
- The necessary skills for help desk, user support, and hardware troubleshooting functions.

The objectives of the programme are to:

- Provide foundations of basic principles, skills and knowledge that will enhance the graduates' carrier development.
- Provide adequate ICT skills and knowledge which will enable the graduates to be competent in solving the ICT and business related problems relevant to their levels of study.
